You will receive an Event Rider Pack in February 2012 giving you final details of the route, meeting point, daily itinerary and hotels, etc. C2C will also aim to give you regular updates on the event either by email or on the website www.cycle2cannes.org

2012 TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Most of these conditions are designed for your safety and the safety of others. In order to participate in C2C 2012, you must agree to the following conditions. Please read these pages carefully, they contain important information.

1. REGISTRATION FORM

All riders must complete and sign our Registration Form, whether riding as an individual or in a team.

2. EXCLUSIVE C2C EVENT

C2C The 'Original' Ride and C2C The 'Chase' Ride are an annual fundraising event and all riders must raise money for the charities C2C will be supporting in 2012. Corporate and Rider Sponsorship Forms are sent to participants. C2C The 'Original' Ride is an endurance sporting event and designed for fit commuter riders as well as hardened roadies. The 'Original' Ride is designed entirely for road bikes and we ride 1500km from London to Cannes over 6 days in relays. The relay made up of three pelotons, will each ride a minimum 100km per day in two sessions. People who wish to ride for longer can do so by participating in the 'Go The Whole Distance' challenge.

The 'Chase' Ride is designed entirely for road bicycles and we ride 1500km from London to Cannes over 4 days in relays. This is a non-stop (24hr) event with riders split into two groups each one riding for a duration of up to 6 hours before having 6 hours off. The relay, made up of 2 pelotons, will ride a minimum of 120km per day over two sessions. Riders are not allowed to ride for longer than 6 hours and must rest for 6 hours between sessions.

3. CHARITY FUNDRAISING

We ask each participant to raise a minimum level of £3000 for C2C's designated charities, over and above the entry fee. The entry fee does not cover the full cost of participating in either ride. A proportion of the money raised will be used to cover these costs. All money should be banked no later than 27th April 2012. All fundraising must be paid direct to Cycle to Cannes. Payments to beneficiary charities will be made by Cycle to Cannes following the event.

4. ENTRY FEES

The cost of participating in either ride of Cycle to Cannes 2012 is £899 (part-funded) and £1649 (fully-funded).

All payments are due by 27th January 2012 for the rider to be eligible for their chosen ride. Payments can be made in installments – please contact Cycle to Cannes for further details.

5. SAFETY

Cycling on the highway is a potentially dangerous activity and, although the organisers, managers and promoters of The 'Original' Ride and The 'Chase' Ride will do all in their power to make the rides safe, all riders take part at their own risk. All riders must ensure that their bicycles are in a roadworthy condition before the start of the event, must observe the rules of the Highway Code, and obey the Golden Rules of the road. This will be included with the Event Rider Pack sent to each registered rider in February 2012.

NB: Neither C2C, nor the Ride Managers accept responsibility for any injury sustained or property damaged in the course of taking part in either ride in the absence of negligence or breach of statutory duty on their parts.

6. LIABILITY/INSURANCE

The organisers, managers and sponsors of The 'Original' Ride and The 'Chase' Ride cannot be held liable for injury, loss and damage caused or sustained as a result of taking part, howsoever arising, nor can they accept any liability for any changes made to either ride for safety reasons, or as otherwise planned through circumstances beyond their control.

While we go to great lengths to ensure that both rides are organised to enable participants to be as safe as possible at all times, we must make it clear that all participants in either ride take part entirely at their own risk. You are therefore strongly advised to comply with our safety guidelines and to obtain personal accident insurance as well as adequate material loss/damage insurance cover in respect of your bicycle and personal property and any loss or injury you may cause to a third party.

2012 TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

7. INSURANCE

Holiday, travel, medical or bike insurance is NOT included in your entry fee. It is very important to get comprehensive travel cover for the trip. Cover for bicycles whilst in use or transit or during the event is also NOT included (check your household policy first to see if your bicycle is covered).

EHIC CARD

In addition, you are also strongly advised to obtain an EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) which entitles you to reduced or sometimes free treatment should you have an accident. To find out more either visit the website www.ehic.org.uk or call 0845 605 0707.

Please allow yourself at least **three weeks** for delivery of your EHIC documentation.

8. DATA PROTECTION

9. HEALTH AND FITNESS

Although our ride is non-competitive and will consist of mixed ability teams, it is important that everyone is well prepared to avoid hindering or delaying the progress of the peloton – we stress, for your own benefit, **that pre-event training is essential.**

C2C reserves the right at any time, should it be necessary, to assess your ability to complete the ride. C2C decision is final.

Cycling can be very strenuous and riders must be in good health. Riders who have any doubt about their health, or have a medical condition that could be affected by exercise, particularly a heart condition, are strongly advised to obtain their doctor's approval before participating. Your health is your responsibility.

10. BIKE COLLECTION

Bikes will be brought back to the UK by road immediately the event is over. They will be available for collection from a Central London location. If, for any reason, you are not able to collect your bike on your return to the UK, you must advise us of the name of the person doing so on your behalf. No liability is accepted for loss of or damage to any bikes or equipment

11. CANCELLATION

We will refund your entry fee (less the £199 non-refundable deposit) if advised of your withdrawal from your chosen event by 5pm on Friday 27th January 2012. We cannot issue refunds, for any reason, after that. If you do subsequently have to cancel your entry, you should claim from your insurers.

12. TIMES AND ITINERARIES

All timings and itineraries are subject to change without notice due to circumstances beyond our control. When signing your application form, you are acknowledging that you have read and accepted these Terms & Conditions. Please ensure that you forward a copy to all your team/group members, if applicable.

13. MIPIM ENTRY

C2C riders who plan to attend the MIPIM property fair must be pre-registered with the organisers Reed Midem. MIPIM takes place between 6-9 March 2012.

C2C wish to emphasise that participation in the C2C 2012 rides does not gain any rider free entry to MIPIM 2012. Registration is at full cost.

MIPIM FAST-TRACK PROCEDURE

MIPIM organisers have set-up a unique fast-track procedure for C2C registered riders. Providing you have registered with MIPIM online by Friday 11 February 2012, C2C will be able to access your badges on your behalf on arrival on Tuesday 6th March 2012.
